The City Traffic Control Division will be upgrading the traffic signal installation on Lindsey Street at the Chautauqua Avenue intersection. Currently, both the northbound and southbound approaches receive green indications simultaneously. This can make it difficult, especially during periods of higher traffic volumes, for the left-turns onto either direction of Lindsey Street to be made. Crews will be modifying the phasing of the intersection so that northbound and southbound approaches come on separate from one another allowing the left-turns to be made much more easily and without conflict from oncoming traffic. This modification may involve some rewiring as well as changes to one signal head on both the northbound and southbound Chautauqua Avenue approaches. This work will take place on Thursday, January 9, 2014, weather permitting. After 9:00 a.m. on January 9th, the intersection will be temporarily controlled by an all-way STOP sign. Signal operation will be restored at the intersection before 12:00 p.m. on the same day.
