

Amanda Nairn, Chair announced that the Environmental Control Advisory Board (ECAB) and Chris Ward with the Cleveland County Conservation District are co-hosting the workshop. Ms. Nairn stated ECAB has been focusing on water quality and water quantity issues over the past 18 months. Some of ECAB's recent activities have included helping work on the Fertilizer Ordinance, created a fertilizer survey, sponsored a children's water poster contest, participated at Earth Day Festival and have conducted several rain barrel workshops.
