Wine and beer permitting laws will change in the State of Oklahoma on October 1, 2018. Low-Point Beer Licenses will no longer be valid after October 1, 2018, for retail beer sales.

The City of Norman is currently working on creating regulations, applications, and fees for City permits, but do not have information at this time. The City anticipates having regulations and fees in place by June 1, 2018, at which time that information will be available online.

The ABLE Commission located at 3812 N. Santa Fe, Suite 200, Oklahoma City, 73118, is in the process of accepting application for Retail Beer and Retail Wine Permits that require a Certificate of Compliance from the City of Norman. Each applicant will need to obtain the required inspections and signatures listed on the Certificate of Compliance.
