



A PROCLAMATION BY THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF
NORMAN DECLARING THE CONCLUSION OF A WATER SHORTAGE
EMERGENCY AS OF August 20, 2012

WHEREAS, the Norman City Council adopted Resolution R-1011-123 on May 31, 2011 adopting the City of Norman Water Conservation Plan 2011 which includes the Drought Contingency Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Water Conservation Plan allows for different conservation measures to be implemented based on differing water demand and supply conditions, and

WHEREAS, Stage 2, Moderate (Mandatory) Conservation Measures may be implemented by the City Manager when the City water demand exceeds the Norman Utilities Authority (NUA) supply capacity by greater than 3 million gallons per day (mgd) for two consecutive days and there is no weather related relief in the immediate forecast; and

WHEREAS, on August 1, 2012, the City Manager signed a proclamation declaring a Stage 2, Moderate Mandatory Conservation due to the demand and weather conditions, and


WHEREAS, the City water demand is no longer exceeding the NUA's supply capacity by greater than 3 mgd on consecutive days; and

NOW THEREFORE, the City Manager of the City of Norman hereby proclaims:


- § 1. THAT, a water shortage emergency no longer exists; and
2. THAT, Stage 2, Moderate (Mandatory) Conservation measures are hereby rescinded.
