Southbound Berry Road to Close between Main and Barbour Starting Monday

The southbound lanes of Berry Road between Main Street and Barbour Street will be closed to through traffic beginning Monday at 9 a.m. to allow installation of new waterlines as part of the Berry Road Waterline Replacement project. Northbound lanes of Berry Road will be open during the project which is expected to take several weeks.

Access south of Kansas Street to Barbour Street will be available for local traffic only.

The southern-most lane of Main will also be closed from Gatewood to just east of Berry Road including the south side of the intersection from Main to Garver.

Warning and detours signs in the area will assist motorists. Suggested alternative routes are Wylie Road or Flood Avenue between Main and Boyd.

The construction, which is phase two of the Berry Road Waterline Replacement project, includes new 16-inch waterlines for both the City of Norman and the University of Oklahoma.
