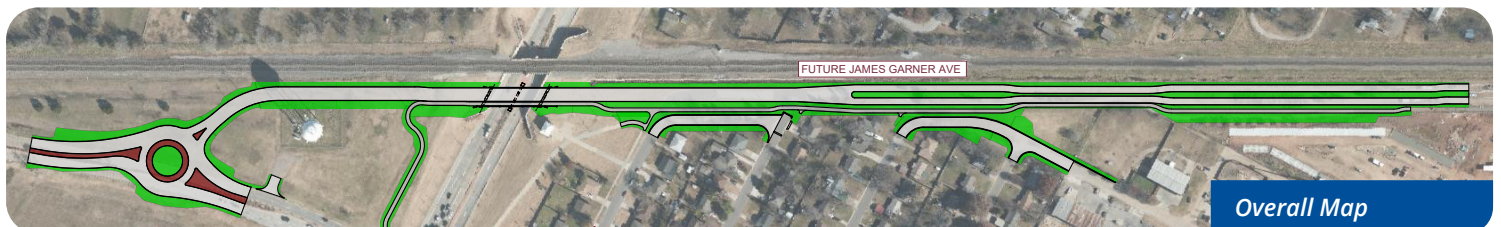

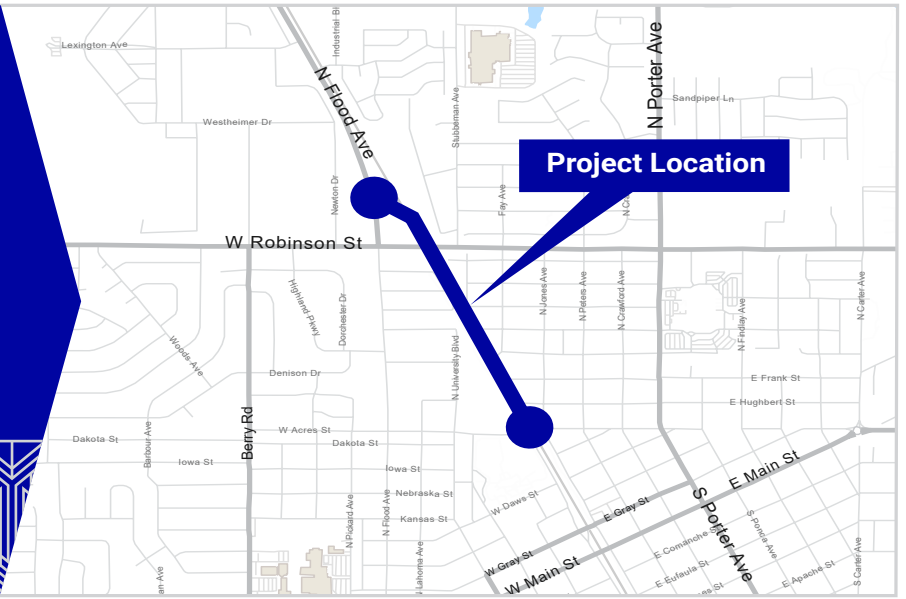
Please join us and fellow Normanites on April 21st at 6pm in the Council Chamber to discuss the road improvements between Acres Street and Flood Avenue.

The improvements will have the following benefits for the community:

- Reduced traffic congestion
- Improved traffic safety
- ADA accessible sidewalks
- More direct connection to downtown Norman
- Realignment of Legacy Trail from Acres Street to Robinson Street
- New roundabout intersection at James Garner Avenue and Flood Avenue
- Improvements to public and private utilities



James Garner Avenue Phase II



The James Garner Phase II extension creates a new uninterrupted corridor into Downtown Norman from Flood Avenue. The project stretches from just north of Acres Street, adjacent to the new library, north over Robinson Street to connect with Flood Avenue.

The project will consist of a new two-lane divided street section, a new bridge over Robinson Street, and a new roundabout intersection at Flood Avenue, along with realignment of portions of the Legacy Trail to provide a safe pedestrian and bicycle path.

The project will provide an alternative route to downtown in an effort to relieve traffic congestion within nearby neighborhoods and on both Flood Avenue and Porter Avenue. **The project budget is \$6,305,000** with an anticipated construction start in the summer of 2022.
