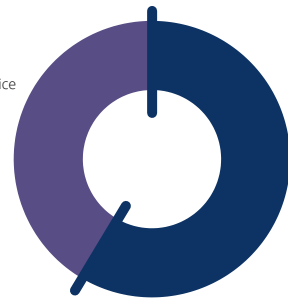

#### WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A HIT-AND-RUN COLLISION INVOLVING A PEDESTRIAN NEAR CENTRAL PKWY AND PELHAM CIR ON 5/12. THE VICTIM WAS ASSISTING A FRIEND IN LOCATING THEIR VEHICLE WHICH HAD BEEN TAKEN WITHOUT PERMISSION. AFTER FINDING THE VEHICLE, THE VICTIM STOOD BEHIND THE VEHICLE WHILE THE FRIEND APPROACHED THE DRIVER. THE DRIVER STARTED THE VEHICLE AND BACKED IT OVER THE VICTIM BEFORE LEAVING THE SCENE. THE VICTIM WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL WITH SIGNIFICANT INJURIES. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY THE NPD/OU PD CIRT TEAM.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 28 ANIMALS ADOPTED, 3 ANIMALS TRANSFERRED TO RESCUE, AND 13 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNER THIS WEEK. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN A TOTAL OF 69 ANIMALS. ANIMAL WELFARE CURRENTLY HAS 215 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 82 OF THOSE ANIMALS IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
- OFFICERS FROM ACROSS THE DEPARTMENT PARTICIPATED IN THE OKLAHOMA LAW ENFORCEMENT TORCH RUN AND SPECIAL OLYMPICS SUMMER GAMES. THESE EVENTS SUPPORT SPECIAL OLYMPICS OF OKLAHOMA WHICH SERVES OVER 12,000 ATHLETES ACROSS THE STATE AS THEY COMPETE IN OLYMPIC-STYLE INDIVIDUAL AND TEAM SPORTS. THE NPD MASCOT, MIKO, WAS ALSO PRESENT TO KICKOFF THE SUMMER GAMES AND WAS A HUGE HIT WITH ALL OF THE ATHLETES.
