WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO THE AREA OF ROCK CREEK AND FLOOD IN REGARD TO A RECKLESS DRIVER ON 5/22. OFFICERS ATTEMPTED TO STOP THE VEHICLE VIA TVI DUE TO THE UNSAFE DRIVING BEHAVIOR BUT WERE UNSUCCESSFUL. THE SUBJECT THEN CRASHED THE VEHICLE AT ROCK CREEK AND FLOOD AND WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY AFTER A SHORT FOOT PURSUIT. NO INJURIES REPORTED. THE SUBJECT WAS TRANSPORTED TO CCDC ON MULTIPLE CHARGES.
- · AN OFFICER ATTEMPTED TO STOP A VEHICLE DRIVING RECKLESSLY NEAR 24TH AVE AND W. MAIN ST ON 5/19. THE VEHICLE DID NOT STOP PROCEEDING ONTO I-35 AT A HIGH RATE OF SPEED. THE VEHICLE EXITED 1-35 IN MOORE AND EVENTUALLY CRASHED. THE DRIVER RAN FROM THE SCENE WHILE A PASSENGER REMAINED IN THE VEHICLE. BOTH THE DRIVER AND PASSENGER WERE IDENTIFIED AS JUVENILES. OFFICERS ALSO LOCATED A LOADED FIREARM IN THE VEHICLE. INVESTIGATION IS ONGOING.
- OFFICERS WERE DISPATCHED TO THE 1300 BLOCK OF 12TH AVE NE. ON 5/25 FOR A FIGHT, INITIAL INVESTIGATION DETERMINED TWO SUBJECTS WERE FIGHTING OVER A GUN AND WHEN ONE SUBJECT FIRED A SHOT WHICH STRUCK THE GROUND. NO ONE WAS INJURED. UPON ARRIVAL. OFFICERS CONTACTED THE SUSPECT WHO WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY AND TRANSPORTED TO CCDC FOR MULTIPLE FELONY CHARGES.
- · ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 38 ANIMALS ADOPTED, 2 ANIMALS TRANSFERRED TO RESCUE, AND 4 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNER THIS WEEK. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN 60 ANIMALS INTO THE CENTER. ANIMAL WELFARE CURRENTLY HAS 229 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 77 OF THOSE ANIMALS CURRENTLY IN FOSTER PLACEMENT.
