WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A DISTURBANCE IN THE 200 BLOCK OF JUSTIN DRIVE ON 5/27. THE REPORTING PARTY REPORTED THAT THEY WERE ASSAULTED BY A GROUP OF INDIVIDUALS AFTER TELLING THEM THE NEIGHBORHOOD POOL WAS CLOSED. THE ALLEGED SUSPECTS WERE GONE ON ARRIVAL. OFFICERS LOCATED THE ALLEGED SUSPECT VEHICLE SHORTLY AFTER LEAVING THE SCENE OF THE INCIDENT, AND CONFIRMED THE INVOLVEMENT OF ONE ADULT FEMALE AND TWO JUVENILE FEMALES. THE ADULT FEMALE WAS ARRESTED AND TRANSPORTED TO THE CLEVELAND COUNTY DETENTION CENTER ON MULTIPLE WARRANTS. WARRANT REQUESTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE ASSAULT WERE ISSUED FOR THE ADULT FEMALE AS WELL AS THE TWO JUVENILE FEMALES.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF A POSSIBLE OVERDOSE IN THE 300 BLOCK OF CHALMETTE DRIVE ON 5/27. UPON ARRIVAL, OFFICERS CONFIRMED ONE INDIVIDUAL WAS IN MEDICAL DISTRESS DUE TO A POTENTIAL OVERDOSE INVOLVING FENTANYL. NARCAN WAS ADMINISTERED AND THE INDIVIDUAL WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL FOR FURTHER TREATMENT. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 50 ANIMALS ADOPTED, 3 ANIMALS TRANSFERRED TO RESCUE, AND 7 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNER THIS WEEK.
 ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN A TOTAL OF 60 ANIMALS INTO THE ANIMAL WELFARE CENTER. ANIMAL WELFARE CURRENTLY HAS 205 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 66 OF THOSE ANIMALS CURRENTLY IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
