### **WEEK IN REVIEW**

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF AN INJURY COLLISION AT FLOOD AVE AND TECUMSEH RD ON 6/3. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT A SEMI-TRUCK TRAVELING SOUTHBOUND ON FLOOD AVE TURNED IN FRONT OF A CAR TRAVELING SOUTHBOUND CAUSING THE CAR TO HIT THE TRUCK. THE DRIVER OF THE CAR WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL FOR INJURIES SUSTAINED DURING THE COLLISION. THE COLLISION REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION BY CIRT.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO AN INJURY COLLISION AT 12TH AVENUE NE AND FRANKLIN AVE INVOLVING FOUR VEHICLES ON 6/6. ONE INDIVIDUAL WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL FOR NON-LIFE-THREATENING INJURIES. THE COLLISION REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION.
- NPD HOSTED THE DALE DEBERRY MEMORIAL REGIONAL AND OKLAHOMA STATE PPC CHAMPIONSHIPS. LT. GARNAND EARNED OKLAHOMA STATE CHAMPION. SEVEN CURRENT AND RETIRED NPD OFFICERS FINISHED IN THE TOP 20 EARNING A PLACE IN THE PRESTIGIOUS GOVERNOR'S 20.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 40 ANIMALS ADOPTED, 2 TRANSFERRED TO RESCUES, AND 12 RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNERS THIS WEEK.
   ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN A TOTAL OF 68 ANIMALS. ANIMAL WELFARE CURRENTLY HAS 203 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 60 OF THOSE ANIMALS IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
