#### **WEEK IN REVIEW**

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF SHOTS FIRED IN THE 3000 BLOCK OF OAK TREE AVE ON 6/10. WHILE RESPONDING TO THE SCENE, DISPATCH BEGAN RECEIVING CALLS FROM INDIVIDUALS STATING THEY WERE VICTIMS OF THE SHOOTING. TWO INDIVIDUALS WERE TRANSPORTED FOR NON-LIFE-THREATENING INJURIES SUSTAINED DURING THE SHOOTING. A THIRD INDIVIDUAL REFUSED MEDICAL TREATMENT AT THE SCENE. OFFICERS ARRESTED TWO IN CONNECTION WITH THE SHOOTING ON ASSAULT WITH A DEADLY WEAPON AS WELL AS ADDITIONAL CHARGES. BOTH WERE BOOKED INTO CCDC. INVESTIGATION IS ONGOING.
- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A SHOOTING IN THE 2500 BLK OF W. MAIN ST. ON 6/10.THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT SEVERAL SHOTS WERE FIRED DURING A DISTURBANCE. THE SUSPECT RAN FROM THE AREA WITH THE FIREARM BEFORE OFFICERS ARRIVED. NO INJURIES WERE REPORTED. OFFICERS ESTABLISHED A PERIMETER AND QUICKLY LOCATED THE SUSPECT. HE WAS TAKEN INTO CUSTODY FOLLOWING A SHORT FOOT PURSUIT AND WAS BOOKED INTO CODE ON MILITIPLE CHARGES.
- COMMUNICATIONS RECEIVED A REPORT OF AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAD HAD BEEN STABBED AFTER AN ARGUMENT AT A CAMPSITE IN THE SUTTON WILDERNESS PARK ON 6/11. THE VICTIM COULD NOT IDENTIFY THE SUSPECT, BUT DID HAVE A CUT ON THEIR HAND AND A PUNCTURE WOUND ON THEIR BACK. THE VICTIM WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOPSITAL. THE INCIDENT REMAINS UNDER INVESTIGATION.
- NPD SWAT TEAM COMPETED IN THE OKLAHOMA STATE COMPETITION AND WON FIRST PLACE IN THE TWO-GUN COMPETITION AS WELL AS SEVERAL OTHER AWARDS.
- ANIMAL WELFARE PARTNERED WITH DOG IS MY COPILOT ON 6/15 AND TRANSFERRED 41
   ANIMALS FROM OUR FACILITY TO RESCUE ORGANIZATIONS IN COLORADO AND OREGON. THIS
   WAS THE SECOND OF 4 SCHEDULED RESCUE FLIGHTS THIS YEAR. ADDITIONALLY, ANIMAL
   WELFARE HAD 34 ANIMALS ADOPTED, 60 ANIMALS TRANSFERRED TO RESCUE, AND 1 ANIMAL
   RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNER THIS WEEK. THEY TOOK IN 85 ANIMALS AND THEY CURRENTLY
   HAVE 175 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 45 OF THOSE ANIMALS IN PLACEMENT WITH
   FOSTERS.
