WEEK IN REVIEW

- OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A REPORT OF AN ASSAULT WITH WEAPONS IN THE AREA OF CREEKSIDE LN AND CREEKSIDE DR ON 9/4. THE VICTIM REPORTED THAT HE SAW TWO UNHOUSED INDIVIDUALS SETTING UP A CAMP NEAR THE TREE LINE. THE VICTIM CONFRONTED THE INDIVIDUALS LEADING TO A VERBAL ARGUMENT. THE ARGUMENT TURNED PHYSICAL WHEN THE INDIVIDUALS STRUCK THE VICTIM WITH LARGE BRANCHES THE VICTIM ATTEMPTED TO RUN AWAY BUT FELL AND WAS ASSAULTED FURTHER. THE INDIVIDUALS RAN FROM THE AREA BUT WERE LOCATED BY OFFICERS NEARBY. THE INDIVIDUALS ADMITTED TO THE ASSAULT AND WERE ARRESTED ON A COMPLAINT OF ASSAULT AND BATTERY WITH A DANGEROUS WEAPON. THE VICTIM WAS TRANSPORTED TO A LOCAL HOSPITAL WITH NON-LIFE-THREATENING INJURIES.
- · OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A WELFARE CHECK OF A VEHICLE STOPPED IN THE 1000 BLK OF W. BROOKS ST ON 9/5. OFFICERS LOCATED TWO CHILDREN, BOTH AGE TWO, INSIDE THE VEHCILE. BOTH WERE PRONOUNCED DECEASED AT THE TIME OF ARRIVAL. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT THE CHILDREN WERE ACCIDENTALLY LEFT IN THE VEHICLE FOR AN EXTENDED PERIOD OF TIME AND WERE LATER FOUND BY FAMILY. THE INVESTIGATION IS ONGOING.
- COMMUNICATIONS RECEIVED A REPORT OF A SHOOTING AT A RESIDENCE IN THE 1800 BLK OF TWISTED OAK DR ON 9/6. UPON ARRIVAL, OFFICERS LOCATED A 52-YEAR-OLD VICTIM WITH MULTIPLE GUNSHIOT WOUNDS AND IMMEDIATELY BEGAN RENDERING MEDICAL AID. THE VICTIM WAS TRANSPORTED TO AN AREA HOSPITAL WHERE THEY LATER DIED. WITNESSES PROVIDED OFFICERS WITH A DESCRIPTION OF THE SHOOTER WHO RAN FROM THE AREA. OFFICERS ESTABLISHED A PERIMITER AND INITIATED A SEARCH. DURING THE SEARCH, OFFICERS LOCATED THE SUSPECT IN THE 1300 BLK OF E. LINDSEY ST. WHERE HE WAS DETAINED AND SUBSEQUENTLY ARRESTED FOR FIRST DEGREE MURDER. THE INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT THE VICTIM AND SUSPECT WERE INVOLVED IN AN ARGUMENT PRIOR TO THE SHOOTING. THE INVESTIGATION IS ONGOING.
- ANIMAL WELFARE HAD 32 ANIMALS ADOPTED. 5 ANIMALS TRANSFERRED OUT TO RESCUE. AND 7 ANIMALS RECLAIMED BY THEIR OWNERS THIS WEEK. ADDITIONALLY, THEY TOOK IN 43 ANIMALS. NORMAN ANIMAL WELFARE HAS 192 ANIMALS IN THEIR CARE WITH 71 OF THOSE ANIMALS CURRENTLY IN PLACEMENT WITH FOSTERS.
